NABIP UNITE PROGRAM "Unite" NABIP in Times of Emergency When natural disasters occur, NABIP's members are there to help those in need.

NABIP UNITE is a communication program designed to assist members with emergency financial support when natural disasters strike.

Here's how the program works:

When a disaster strikes, NABIP identifies any members who may have been affected. Coordinated efforts are put in place to notify all NABIP members of the situation. NABIP members are then asked to donate gift cards to the state or local leadership of the affected area. Gift cards are given directly to NABIP members in need.

This program is designed to give temporary but immediate help while members are awaiting federal funds, insurance proceeds or assistance from organizations like the Red Cross. Gift cards are an effective and expedited way to get NABIP members help immediately.

During disasters, many people lose everything -- their personal belongings, debit cards, driver's license, checks and the like. Gift cards allow NAHU members in need to purchase food, clothing, temporary housing and other essential goods and services.
