

## Who can be a delegate?

Article XI, Section 1 of NABIP's bylaws states:

"The House of Delegates shall consist of:

- A. The Board of Trustees
- B. Past Presidents of NABIP
- C. Delegates of state and local associations as designated in Sections 2 and 3 of this ARTICLE."

To be eligible to be a chapter delegate, the person must be an active member in good standing of the chapter he or she is representing. For example, a delegate for Greater Washington must have all dues paid through June 30, of the current year, for Greater Washington, Maryland and NABIP.

Past state chapter presidents in good standing <u>may be appointed as a delegate for any local</u> chapter in the state of which they presided regardless of their local membership.

**Past NABIP presidents** and **current Board of Trustee members** are not eligible to be state or local chapter delegates; they are already delegates as detailed in NABIP's bylaws, Article XI, Section 1.
